

Supplemental Figure 1: Resuscitation algorithm used for shocked, resuscitated animals (Fasted and Prefed groups). If SBP is observed to be less than 90 mmHg, hemoglobin (Hgb) levels are assessed. If hemoglobin is low, shed blood is given; if not, lactated Ringers are given. Alternately, if SBP is not less than 90 mmHg, urine output (UO) is assessed. If urine output is low, the algorithm proceeds according to hemoglobin levels as described. If urine output is adequate, the animal is observed and reassessed for the full resuscitation period.
