Initially - Negative
• More time spent/patient

Positive
• Avoids unnecessary potentially harmful CDPS

BETTER APPROACH to CDPS

1 Comprehensive, Proactive

- Includes multiple evidence-based CDPS maneuvers
- Selects at risk patients for a CDPS visit



2 Individualized and Personalized CDPS

- Identifies eligible CDPS tailored to the patient



3 Integrated Continuity

- Patient referred to appropriate resource
- Internal and/or external to the practice setting
- Other clinicians in the practice made aware of patients' CDPS goals

OTHER APPROACH to CDPS

1. Disease or condition focused
2. Not individualized
3. May not be integrated with patients' primary care provider



CDPS Focused Resources
(e.g. colon cancer screening, diabetes workshop, etc.)

- Specific tests
- Workshops focused on specific condition



Initially - Positive
• Less time spent/patient

Negative
• If not individualized inappropriate tests may be ordered (e.g. colon cancer screen in low risk groups)
