Management

Your patient may have suffered from a TIA and the estimated seven day [stroke risk](#) is Low

You have two management options:

a) Refer to [TIA Clinic](#) AND (before patient leaves surgery):

Initiate/continue ALL of the following Medications:

[Clopidogrel](#) OR [Aspirin](#) +/- [Dipyridamole](#) (UNLESS patient is on [Warfarin](#) or [Dabigatran](#))

AND

[Statin](#) AND [Antihypertensive](#)

AND

Counsel patient on [Smoking Cessation](#) AND No [Driving](#) for minimum of 1 month.[Print TIA Information Leaflet](#)

OR

b) Arrange comprehensive TIA/stroke work-up in the community (see 'Management' tab).
