The Ebola Contact Tracing (ECT) app




Figure 2: Sierra Leone (SL) Ebola case registration – Main summary screen

The app had three modules plus an SMS-based alert system (Table 1; Figures 2 - 16):

1) Registration: Following laboratory-confirmation, the case and their contacts were registered

on the ECT app by trained DHMT staff using an electronic SIM-enabled tablet at the DHMT




Figure 3: SL Ebola case registration – Registration screen

Data Office (Figures 2 and 3).

2) Assignment: CTCs (one per Chiefdom) assigned the contacts registered for each confirmed


Figure 4: SL Assignment module-Start screen

Ebola case to one or more CTs in their Chiefdom (Figures 4 - 10).




Figure 10: SL Assignment Module – Contact assignment screen (note: real contact tracer names were used for the main study version of the ECT app)

3) Visitation: The CTs entered data on the ECT app during the daily monitoring visit to a

contact. This was then synchronized to a central server as soon as a data connection over a

mobile phone network was available. This applied to all entered data: registration, assignment

and visitation (Figures 10 - 16).

4) Telerivet alert: This system was designed to alert the DHMT to symptomatic contacts

identified using the ECT app through an automated SMS dispatch built into the CommCare

platform. The DHMT offices had consistent internet connectivity and could always send and

receive information from the system.

ECT app registration stage

The ECT app registration stage is the stage at which the confirmed Ebola case and their contacts

were registered on the app at the district by the data coordinator.

ECT Assignment stage app

The ECT Assignment stage was the stage at which the contacts of the Ebola cases that were registered at the registration stage were assigned by contact tracing coordinators to a contact tracer(s) in their Chiefdom.

ECT Visitation stage app

The ECT Visitation stage of the app was the stage in which the contact tracer used the app to monitor the Ebola contact for 21 days. Features including whether the Ebola contact was well or sick, and if they were, sick, what their symptoms were. Additional information including the GPS location of the Ebola contact was also recorded.




Figure 14: SL Visitation – Start of Daily contact tracing visit screen
