Systematic Database Search

A systematic search for recent literature relevant to the scope of the research question was conducted by a health sciences librarian.

<u>List of Databases Searched</u>: Seven databases were searched in total: Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health (CINAHL), Cochrane Library (Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews and Cochrane Central Register of Controlled Trials), Embase, MEDLINE, MEDLINE In-Process, PsychINFO, and Educational Resource Information Centre (ERIC).

Research Question: What education and professional development is required by health-care providers to ensure effective screening, assessment, and management of perinatal depression?

Inclusion Criteria:

The following criteria were used to guide the search:

- A primary focus of the article is on the topic area: health-care provider education required for
 assessment and management of perinatal (antenatal or postpartum) depression in pregnant
 women or women with a newborn or infant less than 12 months. Education can focus on caring
 for women with co-existing mental health disorders during pregnancy or postpartum (e.g.
 anxiety) but primary focus of education must be on perinatal depression
- Study methodology limited to all types of primary studies: quantitative, qualitative, mixed methods, and reviews
- Published between January 2006 and June 2015
- Published in English
- Accessible for retrieval
- Applicable across health settings/sectors where nurses provide direct clinical care to pregnant or postpartum women
- Primary focus on nurses (registered nurses, registered practical nurses, nurse practitioners, etc.)
- Secondary focus on other health-care providers (whose scope of practice overlaps with nursing)
- Applicable to nurses in a Canadian context

Exclusion Criteria:

The following criteria were used to exclude literature from the search:

- Topic not related to education of health-care providers on perinatal depression, or focus of education is solely on other mental illnesses beyond the topic area (e.g., eating disorders, bipolar disorder, postpartum psychosis, postpartum blues, etc.).
- Dissertations, commentaries, narrative, anecdotal articles, letters to the editor, editorials, expert reports, consensus documents, discussion papers, case studies, case series
- Studies without specified methodology that cannot be quality appraised
- Non-English studies
- Unpublished (grey literature)
- Studies involving animals
- Articles focusing only on providing patient education related to perinatal depression
- Articles with a specific focus on providing education related to pharmacologic interventions
