

Follow-up data of usable quality for statistical analysis ${ }^{4}$
450 pupils never had the opportunity to complete demographic data (see above 316 , plus ( $498-364$ ) $134=450$ ). Mainly due to withdrawal of one school from baseline.
230 pupils opted not to complete the demographic data. 82 pupils opted not to complete over $75 \%$ of the variables required for this analysis.

Thus, 762 pupils were excluded from statistical analysis.
Leaving data from $N=24, n=5092$ (67\% of those participating at haceline)
Pupils whose demographic data, including social class, were subsequently collected at follow-up.
Baseline data was collected from Cohort 1 mid-August to mid-December 1996 and Cohort 2 mid-August to mid-December 1997

Follow-up data was collected from Cohort 1 mid-August to midDecember 1998 and Cohort 2 mid-August to mid-December 1999
Percentage of those in the original eligible sample.
Pupils had been told they could omit specific questions if too sensitive
