

STUDY SAMPLE n=144

33 midwives, 66 child health nurses, 21 dental hygienists/dental nurses, 24 open pre-school teachers

DECLINED PARTICIPATION n=10
3 midwives, 6 child health nurses,
1 dental hygienist/dental nurses

RESPONSE RATE PRE-IMPLEMENTATION 93% n=134

midwives 91% (n=30), child health nurses 91% (n=60), dental hygienists/dental nurses 95% (n=20), open pre-school teachers 100% (n=24)

LOST TO FOLLOW-UP n=25
8 midwives, 12 child health nurses, 1
dental hygienist/dental nurse, 4 open
pre-school teachers. Of these, 8 declined
participation **and** 17 had changed
employer, were retired or on sick leave

RESPONSE RATE POST-IMPLEMENTATION 81% n=109

midwives 73% (n=22), child health nurses 80% (n=48), dental hygienists/dental nurses 95% (n=19), open pre-school teachers 83% (n=20)
