Dependent from government and not integrated with other sectors

No pesticides laws but strong social participation

Advocacy, social mobilization, legislation

Collaborations among sectors

Pesticides are regulated, strong social commitments

Based on larval control with limited adult control. Closely integrated with community

Independent but also collaborates with department of agriculture, consumer services, and public health sectors
