DESCRIPTION OF PREP

PrEP stands for Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis. PrEP is a pill that is taken every day to prevent HIV. PrEP is for people who do not have HIV but are worried about getting it and want to stay HIV negative. PrEP contains some of the medicines in ARVs. Research has shown that PrEP is safe. PrEP involves taking one tablet (swallowed by mouth) every day. It must be taken every day in order to be effective.

PrEP protects against HIV infection much like a malaria pill protects against malaria or a daily birth control pill protects against pregnancy. PrEP does not protect against other STIs or pregnancy and it is not a cure for HIV.
