## Study inclusion and exclusion criteria

## Inclusion

•Symptoms of stress urinary incontinence and/or mixed urinary incontinence, predominantly stress incontinence

•Signs of stress urinary incontinence on physical examination or voiding diary

•Patient is a candidate for surgical treatment (as based on history and physical examination)

•Patient has attended at least 3 months of pelvic floor exercises

•Patient is capable to fill out bladder diaries and questionnaires and understands the Dutch written and spoken language

## **Exclusion**

Previous incontinence surgery

•Mixed urinary incontinence, urge component is predominant

•Pelvic organ prolapse > 1cm beyond the hymen on Valsalva in supine position

•Post void urinary residual > 150ml on ultrasound or catheterisation

Additional pelvic surgery (prolapse and/or hysterectomy)

•Patient is or wants to become pregnant

•Prior pelvic radiotherapy
