Cognitive skills for daily decision-making

Making decisions regarding tasks of daily life—e.g., when to get up or have meals, which clothes to wear or activities to do.

- 0. Independent—Decisions consistent, reasonable, and safe
- Modified independence—Some difficulty in new situations only
 Minimally impaired—In specific recurring situations, decisions become poor or unsafe;
- cues/supervision necessary at those times
 3. Moderately impaired—Decisions consistently poor or unsafe; cues/supervision required
- Moderately impaired—Decisions consistently poor or unsafe; cues/supervision required at all times
- 4. Severely impaired—Never or rarely makes decisions
- 5. No discernible consciousness, coma
