Interview guide

- 1. Introduction (prior to the start of the tape)
 - a. Introduce the research project, the aim and the background of the study.
 Describe briefly your involvement and interest in research.
 - b. Explain the conditions of the interview (oral and written information).
 - c. If the interviewee has no further questions regarding the conditions, let him or her sign the informed consent.
 - d. Start the tape.
- 2. Have you ever not used GP care (due to costs)?

Prompts:

- a. Reasons for not using the healthcare (deductible, costs, time, travel time, work, fear, complications, relationship with GP/physician)
- b. Perceived expected health benefits
