*<u>Fake</u>:* Medicines active pharmaceutical ingredient (API) content, formulation, source, as well as other components are deliberately misrepresented.

<u>Non-Equivalent</u>: Presumption of functional equivalence is incorrect. Will not cause equivalent effect if used exactly like compound being substituted for.

<u>Substandard</u>: New product does not meet specified standards. Safety and or efficacy are compromised because components not at specified levels or quality. <u>Degraded</u>: Known branded product distributed in ways unwarranted by brand owner. May include: expired, re-packaged, re-distributed, poorly stored. Packaging may be identical to original.
