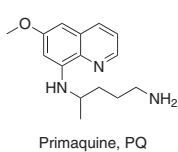
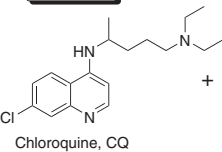


■ **P. vivax** WHO first line treatment: CQ + PQ for 14 days

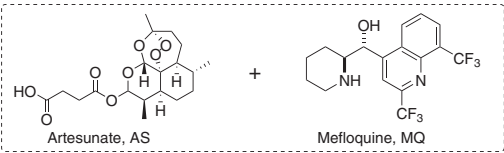

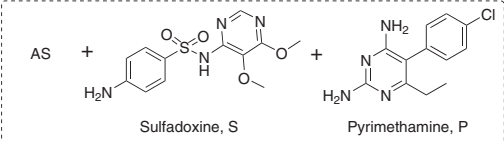

■ **Uncomplicated P. falciparum**

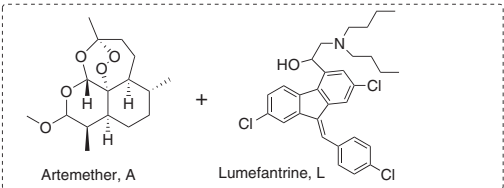
WHO first line treatment: A+L, AS+amodiaquine, AS+MQ, AS+S+P, dihydroartemisinin+piperazine

Country: Ecuador

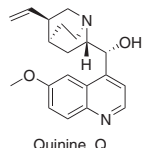
