Minimal Clinically Important Difference (MCID)

MCID= change in the measure that a child thinks makes a difference to their lives.

Get young person to fill out SF36-PFS for how they feel now. Take a red pen and get the young person to mark the SMALLEST AMOUNT the responses would have to change to make a difference to them.

What would be the SMALLEST AMOUNT these would have to change by for you to feel like treatment has made a difference to you?
