Advantages

- Immediate harvesting in case of IVM (can start treatment without delay)
- No male partner/gamete donor needed
- Complete gonadotoxic and or ionizing radiation treatment without exposing gametes Preserve fertility
- Avoid risk of cancer re-transmission
- IVM suitable for prepubertal girls
- IVM is best suited for patients with polycystic ovaries containing numerous small antral follicles
- Oocyte cryopreservation becoming more successful

Disadvantages

- Oocytes sensitive to cryoinjury
- Requires surgical procedures for tissue harvesting or follicle aspiration
- Oocyte retrieval requires 2 to 3 weeks for induction of multiple follicular maturation (place patient at risk of ovarian hyperstimulation syndrome)
- Oocyte retrieval not suitable for prepubertal girls
- IVM has low success rate
