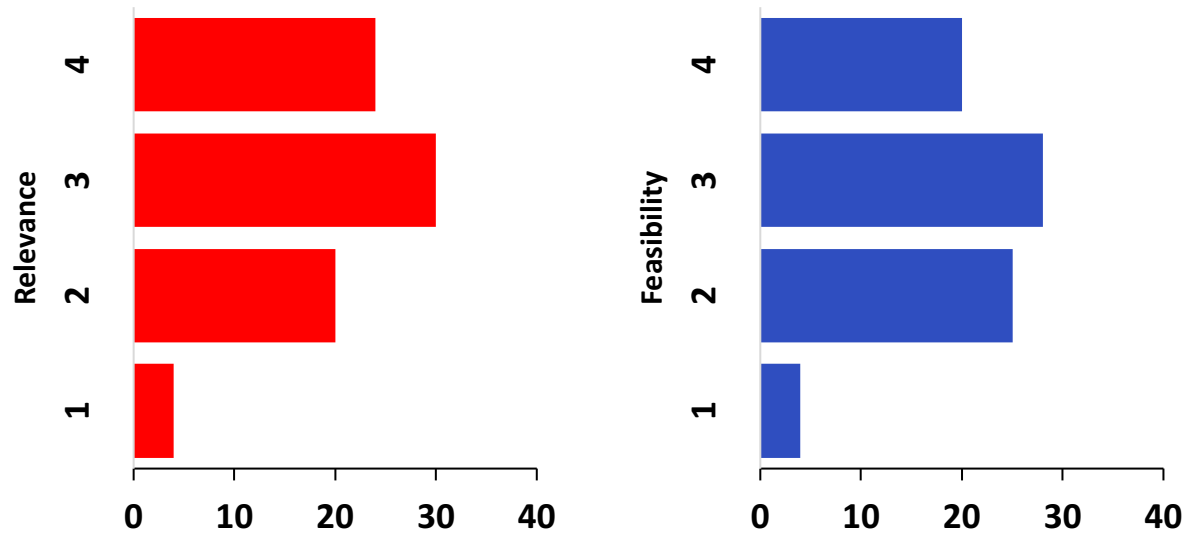


1. Stakeholders working on the policy
