Dear Editor,

On behalf of all authors, I am delighted to submit a manuscript entitled "The p-STAT3/ promotes Caspase-1-mediated hepatocyte pyroptosis non-alcoholic steatohepatitis" your appreciation and to the editorial analysis of the Jounral of Translational Medicine, as to the possibility of its publication.

In our study, the results of both bioinformatic analyses and experiments revealed the expression level of ANXA2 was up-regulated in both LPS-treated hepatocytes and NASH liver, and the inhibition of ANXA2 expression can suppress the associated hepatocyte pyroptosis and fibrosis. According to the analysis of upstream transcription factors of ANXA2, it was observed that the highly expressed p-STAT3 could promote the transcription of Anxa2 by binding with its promoter. The p-STAT3/ANXA2 axis can activate the Caspase-1 and thus mediating the hepatocyte pyroptosis and fibrosis of NASH. Our study is the first to report the role of p-STAT3/ANXA2 axis in NASH, providing a new therapeutic target for clinical treatment.
