

One study (Milner, 2005) reports three levels of use for each *kind* of research, based on different categories of staff (nurses, staff, managers and educators). Profetto-McGrath (2003) did not report instrumental research use and Estabrooks (2007) did not report on persuasive or conceptual research use. Thus, six articles account for 26 measures reported in this table.
