

MIXED CRYOGLOBULINEMIA SYNDROME

SERUM MIXED CRYOGLOBULINS ALONE

Monitoring without treatment
Possible preclinical condition with RF+ and/or low complement
Careful clinical evaluation of possible underlying infectious, autoimmune and/or lymphoproliferative/neoplastic disorders

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MIXED CRYOGLOBULINS + CLINICAL MC SYMPTOMS

Classical MC syndrome (cryoglobulinemic vasculitis) essential or secondary to other infectious, autoimmune and/or lymphoproliferative/neoplastic disorders

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CLINICAL MC SYMPTOMS WITHOUT SERUM MIXED CRYOGLOBULINS

Absence of cryoprecipitable CIC
Repeat cryoglobulin detection at different time intervals to confirm the diagnosis of MC syndrome.
Exclude other infectious, autoimmune and/or lymphoproliferative/neoplastic disorders

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
