Supplemental Methods:

Septic Shock Criteria for Original Study:

- (1) At least 2 systemic inflammatory response syndrome (SIRS) criteria (see below) secondary to proven or suspected infection, PLUS
 - o Temperature >38 or <36 degrees Celsius
 - Heart rate >90th percentile for age
 - Respiratory rate >90th percentile for age, or hyperventilation to PaCO2 <32 Torr
 - White blood cell count >12,000 or <4,000
- (2) Cultures either pending or positive, PLUS
- (3) Two distinct measurements of hypotension (mean arterial pressure or systolic blood pressure <3rd percentile for age) after 20 ml/kg of crystalloid or colloid, PLUS
- (4) At least one of the following:
 - Requirement of vasoactive support, OR
 - GCS <15 (in the absence of CNS disease), OR
 - o Blood lactic acid level >1.6 mmol/L, OR
 - Urine output <1 ml/kg/hr
