a <u>Gastrointestinal tract</u>. Cytoplasmic staining of colonic epithelial cells with gradient of staining from surface epithelium toward lowermost parts of the crypts (magnification x 100). b <u>Kidney</u>. Intense cytoplasmic staining of proximal tubules (black arrows heads) and lack of staining of glomeruli (white arrows heads) (magnification x 100). c <u>Lung</u>. Cytoplasmic staining of bronchial cells (white arrow head), alveolar macrophages (black arrow head) and pneumocytes (black arrows) (magnification x 100). d <u>Adrenal gland</u>. Cytoplasmic staining of the cortex (white arrow head) and lack of staining of medulla (black arrow head) (magnification x 50).
