Traumatic Brain Injury Management

Admission to the ICU Stage 1 therapy

ICP >20mmHg within 72 hours of injury - Check eligibility, obtain consent then RANDOMISE the patient

Control Group

Standard Care (Stage 1+2)

without therapeutic hypothermia

Barbiturates not permitted

Treatment Group

Standard Care (Stage 1+2)

HYPOTHERMIA 32-35°C for ≥ 48 hours 20-30 ml/kg infusion of refrigerated 0.9% saline then a cooling technique available at the centre

Barbiturates not permitted

Stage 3 Options (if required)

Continued Medical Care
Barbiturate Therapy with processed EEG
monitoring

Decompressive Craniectomy

Decompressive Craniectomy Further surgical intervention if required

Day 28, hospital discharge or death

Modified Oxford Handicap Scale Length of Stay in ICU and Hospital

6 month Follow-up

Extended Glasgow Outcome Scale questionnaire
