

Additional file 1. The Eight E-learning Modules of the Mental Health Online Program.

| Module | Aim |
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| 1. Suicidality among adolescents | Gives an overall introduction to the subject of adolescent suicidality and provides the gatekeeper with valuable information on this topic |
| 2. Risk factors | The most common and important risk factors which underlie adolescent suicidality are discussed |
| 3. Ethnicity | Discusses the relationship between ethnicity and adolescent suicidality, and provides the gatekeeper with the required skills when interacting with adolescents from ethnic minority groups |
| 4. Recognition of suicidality | The most important and common warning signs associated with adolescent suicidality are discussed |
| 5. Conversation with the suicidal adolescent | The gatekeeper is provided with a framework and the skills required when engaging in a conversation with a suicidal adolescent |
| 6. Conversation with the parents | Important steps and skills are provided regarding when and how to engage in a conversation with the parents of a suicidal adolescent |
| 7. Suicide first-aid | Discusses how to give first-aid to an adolescent who has attempted suicide |
| 8. Care and aftercare (for schools) | A module specially designed for schools which offers them guidelines regarding the process of care and aftercare when an adolescent commits or attempts suicide |
