4. Recognition of suicidality	The most important and common warning signs associated with adolescent suicidality are discussed
5. Conversation with the suicidal adolescent	The gatekeeper is provided with a framework and the skills required when engaging in a
	conversation with a suicidal adolescent
6. Conversation with the parents	Important steps and skills are provided regarding when and how to engage in a conversation with
	the parents of a suicidal adolescent
7. Suicide first-aid	Discusses how to give first-aid to an adolescent who has attempted suicide
8. Care and aftercare (for schools)	A module specially designed for schools which offers them guidelines regarding the process of care
