Representative sections of neuroanatomical volumes used for multiple voxel-wise comparisons corrections in region-of-interest analyses based on prior anatomical hypotheses (see text). Bihemispheric regions of interest are rendered on sections of the mean normalised brain template for the patient cohort. For the contrasts assessing temporal processing and prosodic predictability processing, the anatomical region of interest (green, above) comprised bilateral posterior superior temporal gyrus/sulcus, planum temporale, supramarginal gyrus. striatum (caudate and putamen), supplementary motor cortex and anterior cingulate. For the contrast assessing phonemic processing, the anatomical region for small volume correction (lilac, below) was a subregion comprising left posterior superior temporal gyrus/sulcus, planum temporale and supramarginal gyrus.
