- Aorta to left atrial fistula is rare and its causes can be congenital or acquired.
- We report a case of a 10 years old boy acquired aorta to left atrial fistula associated with an air gun pellet injury
- The patient was operated on following the detection of a ruptured sinus of valsalva aneurysm and aorta to left atrial fistula via echocardiography
- Our case is the first description of aorta to left atrial fistula caused by an air gun pellet injury
