## Why carry out this study?

- Psoriatic arthritis adds to the already substantial burden of disease in patients with psoriasis, including a significant impact on physical function and activities of daily living.
- The population-based Multinational Assessment of Psoriasis and Psoriatic Arthritis (MAPP) survey examined the impact of psoriatic arthritis on patients' activities of daily living and unmet treatment needs.

## What was learned from the study?

- Psoriatic arthritis is undertreated.
- Improved screening of patients with psoriasis may lead to more diagnoses and earlier treatment of psoriatic arthritis, potentially impacting the burden of disease.
- Appropriate treatment, referral to specialists, and effective communication between patients and their physicians may improve outcomes in patients with psoriatic arthritis.

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
