

**Supplemental Figure 1**. Diagnostic procedure flowchart used by radiologists for determining immediate cause of death. The radiologists checked the existence of large hematoma or massive bleeding followed by the exploration of organ injuries for tentative diagnosis. Then, they verified the validity of the tentative diagnosis using antemortem clinical information such as laboratory data, vital signs, and FAMI, and finally determined the immediate cause of death. FAMI, final antemortem CT imaging
